COMPOST SITE

The Village of Stratford operates a compost site located in the Business / Industrial Park. The site is open to residents from May through October as noted on the annual Garbage and Recycling Calendar.

Every Other Monday Evening
5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Every Other Saturday Morning
9:00 a.m. - Noon

Compost is an excellent source of organic matter to add to your garden or potted plants, and can be used for all your planting needs. It contributes good aeration and moisture-holding capacity, improving soil structure and adding necessary plant nutrients.

Compost is comprised of “brown” and “green” biodegradable waste. “Brown” waste refers to old straw and leaves, tough vegetable stems, and hedge clippings. “Green” waste refers to biodegradable waste that breaks down faster, such as fruit, coffee grounds, cut flowers, and grass clippings.

Compost items for drop off should be in clear bags or your reusable containers. Compost and wood chips are available FREE OF CHARGE for Village residents.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION



To help residents with Spring and Fall clean up of yards and gardens, the Public Works crew will pick up your leaves, grass clippings and garden materials. Please refer to the annual Garbage and Recycling Calendar for the dates of this special collection of yard waste.

- All tree brush and branches must be bundled, not larger than 2 feet in diameter by 8 feet in length, and not heavier than 50 pounds per bundle.
- Keep thorny brush in separate bundles not longer than 3 feet in length.
- Do not set brush out earlier than 48 hours before the Yard Waste Collection dates.
- The property owner is responsible for all terrace clean up.
