

Special Pick-Up Days

Fall Clean Up: Collection of discarded household items such as mattresses, carpet, appliances, furniture, excess garbage, etc... NO tires, waste oil or filters, electronics or construction materials.

Curbside Yard Waste Collection: Prepare your leaves, grass clippings & garden materials in CLEAR plastic bags only. All tree brush & branches must be bundled, not larger than 2' x 8', and not heavier than 50 lbs.

INFORMATION FOR THE NOVEMBER 3rd GENERAL ELECTION

- * Visit myvote.wi.gov to make sure you're registered and/or request an absentee ballot. Remember to include a **photo ID** with the absentee request.
- * Please **IGNORE** any mailings/postcards you receive that instruct you to sign and mail to the clerk's office. These are sent by special interest groups, & omit important information about voting. Instead, use the MyVote website or contact us directly.
- * **EARLY VOTING** is from Tues., Oct. 20th - Sat, Oct. 31st in the Clerk's office. Hours are weekdays from 8:00am – 4:30pm. Evening/weekend slots are also available by appointment. Avoid the lines on election day, and ensure your vote counts!
Remember to bring a photo ID.
- * IF YOU VOTE **ABSENTEE** (aka 'by mail'): mail back your ballot IMMEDIATELY – at least a week before the election – or drop it off in the Clerk's office (or in the drop box next to our front door!) The ballot **MUST** be **received** by **8:00pm** on election day. Make sure you: **SIGN & DATE** your envelope, and have your **WITNESS** sign and write their complete address. The ballot will not be counted if these are missing.
