Review of FFY2023-2026 STP Local Grant application – Chad Grundemann was present to answer questions regarding the application.

Ordinance §590-92 Fences and hedges – Members review examples of other municipalities ordinances.

Motion by Schoenfuss/Spaeth to add 3-foot set back to all residential fences from property line. All existing fences are grandfathered in. Carried.

Annual Sidewalk inspection – Limited number of residents have applied for Sidewalk grant. Committee will have sidewalks inspected after the Sidewalk grant work is completed.

Replacement key tags for park facilities – Motion by Schoenfuss/Spaeth to purchase new key tags for park facilities. Carried.

Review request for changes to tennis court – Options will be reviewed at budget time.

Review of the Annual Wastewater Treatment Plant Compliance and Maintenance report – Motion by Spaeth/Schoenfuss to approve Annual Wastewater Treatment Plant Compliance and Maintenance report. Carried.

Possible extension of Platinum St in Industrial Park – Economic Development has a potential buyer for a lot in the Industrial Park, they are requesting the Village extend Platinum St to Drake Ave. Committee requests that Economic Development has a firm commitment before considering Platinum St extension.

Review of Community Survey – Blighted properties being address with Village attorney. Some sidewalk issues will be addressed with Sidewalk Repair grant. Looking for grant possibilities to update parks and playground equipment. Will look for long-term replacement at budget time.

Review of Stewardship Plan – Nothing new to report.

Director of Public Works report – Dennee reported he has been having to issue more weed notices than in years past. Purple streetlights are being replaced. Infield lights have been changed at Connor Park.
