



Spring Clean Up Day

- Curbside collection of discarded household items, such as mattresses, carpet, major appliances, furniture, excess garbage, etc... for Village residents ONLY.
- NO computers, electronics, televisions, microwaves, waste oil or filters, construction materials, or items brought in from outside the Village.
- Remember that the garbage collectors are mere humans lifting and moving an extraordinary amount of stuff the entire day. If there's an item you can break or cut down to a more manageable size, please be considerate! They have the right to leave something behind they deem unmanageable.
- In general, expect your pickup day to be the same as a normal week (Thursday or Friday). However, we do urge everyone to place their items curbside on Wednesday evening. If the Thursday crew working on the North side of State Highway 153 completes their work early, they may begin on the South side Thursday afternoon. Then come back and focus on the South side on Friday.

Please keep in mind that the garbage collectors WILL NOT sort through your piles for accepted items. If there are unaccepted items at the top of the pile, do not expect them to look through the rest to find the things they will take. If there's something you're not sure they'll take, make sure it's separate from everything else and be prepared to dispose of it on your own or call Harter's Disposal at 715-446-5400 for clarification.

Siren Testing

Mid-April is statewide Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness week. Expect to hear periodic testing of our outdoor warning sirens.



Yard Waste Collection

- ◆ Curbside collection of leaves, grass clippings and garden materials. Use clear plastic bags only.
- ◆ All tree brush and branches must be bundled, not larger than 2 feet in diameter by 8 feet in length, and not heavier than 50 lbs per bundle. Keep thorny brush in separate bundles not longer than 3 feet in length.
- ◆ Do not set brush out earlier than 48 hours before yard clean up dates. The property owner is responsible for all terrace clean up.
- ◆ Our Public Works crew will likely pick up the brush throughout the week. If they didn't get to your house right away, please give them time to make their rounds.

What is the Automatic Payment Plan?

You can save time and money by automatically paying your utility bill (water, electric and sewer) through your checking or savings account. There is no charge for this service. You will continue to receive your monthly utility bill as usual. Automatic payments are processed each month on the due date listed on your utility bill (with adjustments for bank holidays).

Stratford Water & Electric Automatic Payment Plan Agreement

- I realize that utility bills may vary substantially, depending on usage and rates. Normal procedures will provide plenty of time to review my bill prior to deduction from my account.
- I hereby authorize Stratford Water & Electric to initiate entries to the bank account I have designated.
- I authorize that financial institution to debit my account for those entries. This authorization will remain in effect until I terminate it allowing reasonable time for Stratford Water & Electric and my bank to act on the termination.
- I have the right to stop payment on an individual entry or to have entries corrected by timely notification to my financial institution.
- I understand that a returned check fee, plus applicable bank fees, will be charged when my bank account has insufficient funds for a payment to be processed. I further understand Stratford Water & Electric has the right to cancel this agreement for insufficient payments.
- I understand Stratford Water & Electric will keep my banking information confidential.
