

Keep garbage cans off the street

Snowplow crews rely on residents' help to place garbage and recycling carts behind the curb especially when it is trash pick-up day. Carts placed in the street interfere with snowplowing operations. Crews are unable to plow the streets from curb-to-curb when carts are in the street.

Carts placed behind the curb also help street sweeping operations in the spring and fall and snow removal in the winter.

Carts damaged by negligence, including placement in the street, will be replaced with a \$75 charge to the property owner.



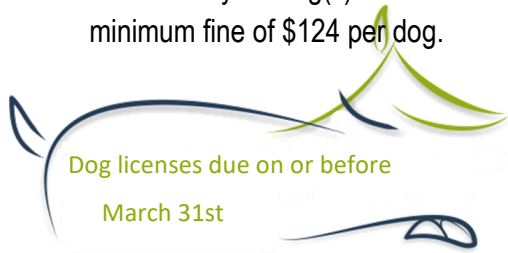
State law requires that all dogs are licensed.

Bring proof of current rabies vaccination to the village office to purchase a license.

Fees are \$10 if the dog is spayed or neutered and \$20 if it is not fixed.

A late fee of \$30 per dog is applied on April 1st.

Failure to license your dog(s) will result in a minimum fine of \$124 per dog.



Snow Removal



Residents are responsible for removing snow and ice from the sidewalk. If it is not removed within 24 hours, the Village crew will clear the path and invoice the property owner! You may not move snow from your property or sidewalk and deposit it onto the street, alley, or sidewalk. **Ordinance §449-10**

Winter parking restrictions are still in effect through April 1st, regardless of the presence of snow. Vehicles cannot be parked on any village street or state highway between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m.
