

VILLAGE OF STRATFORD
Board of Review
Tuesday, May 21, 2019
Municipal Building

The Board of Review was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Village Clerk June Krueger. Members present: Keith Grell, June Krueger, Katie Marten, Tonia Ochoa, and Maryel Schoenfuss. Assessor Greg Schmidt was also in attendance.

Krueger confirmed that the Open Book and Board of Review notice was published in The Record-Review and posted at the Village's three designated public locations as required.

Motion by Grell / Ochoa to nominate Katie Marten as Chair of the Board of Review. Carried. Seeing no other nominations, motion by Grell / Ochoa to close the nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Katie Marten as Chair of Board of Review. Carried.

Motion by Grell / Marten to nominate Maryel Schoenfuss as Vice-Chairperson of the Board of Review. Hearing no other nominations, motion by Grell / Ochoa to close the nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Maryel Schoenfuss as Vice-Chair of the Board of Review. Carried.

Krueger reported:

- The Board of Review Training Affidavit was provided to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue on May 2nd, 2019, affirming that June Krueger and Keith Grell have completed the approved Board of Review training within the past two years.
- The Village of Stratford Ordinance Section 137-9 provides for the confidentiality of income and expense information provided for Board of Review purposes.

Krueger shared a summary from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue regarding two law changes related to property assessment.

Krueger gave Greg Schmidt his oath of office as Assessor. Schmidt has provided the Clerk with the 2019 Assessment Roll and shared that the locally assessed property values have increased by nearly \$2,000,000 over 2018 values, an increase of 2.19%. Assessor Schmidt verified that one change from the Open Book session has been included in the Assessment Roll.

The Board of Review proceeded to examine the Roll for errors and omissions.

Following the review, Chair Marten reported that the Board of Review found no errors or omissions, and no property owners appeared to object to their assessments.
