What is HERITAGE TRAIL all about?

Stratford's Heritage Trail is a year-round outdoor trail system for non-motorized recreation located in the Village of Stratford in western Marathon County. Popular among local hikers, bikers, snow-shoers and cross-country skiers, Heritage Trail provides an excellent outdoor venue for residents and visitors to view and enjoy the nature of the Central Wisconsin region. Utilizing the 73-acre conservancy area south of the Village's Business & Industrial Park and the Stratford School's athletic facility to the northwest, trail users experience a variety of terrains and natural habitats. The trail is handicap accessible, surfaced in crushed rock with ADA-compliant boardwalks in the wetland areas.

How did Heritage Trail come to be? Recognizing the valuable resource in the conservancy area, Village of Stratford officials applied for grant funding from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Matching funds were approved through the DNR's Stewardship Program for Phase One construction in 2009 - 2011. It was the goal of the planning committee to use this initial phase of the trail to link other local recreational facilities — the school forest and athletic fields, FFA Park, Klemme Reserve, and Knoll Fitness Center.

Though much of Phase One utilized public property, several private property owners kindly provided recreational easements for trail access. Cash and in-kind donations from private and corporate donors complimented a generous gift from the Marathon County ATC Reparations Fund to take Phase One of Stratford's Heritage Trail from concept to reality.

Where can I park? The trail's parking lot and trailhead shelter is conveniently located on Parkview Drive in the Business & Industrial Park. Enter the B/I Park at South Wisconsin Avenue -- the lot is just two blocks south. Parking is also available at the Fire Station on South Weber Avenue or at the FFA Park or Tiger Stadium on North Weber Avenue.

Can I walk my dog? Dogs are allowed on the Trail. Your pet, however, is not allowed to run loose and must be on a leash not more than ten feet long. In no way should a pet pose any threat or harm to other trail users or wildlife. "Droppings" must be immediately cleaned up and properly disposed of. Several Pet Waste Stations have been installed.

What are the hours? Village park hours are 6:00 a.m. to midnight. The trail is not lighted, so using it during the daylight is advised.

Is there a fee to use the Trail? No, but donations are welcome and always appreciated. Donated funds are used to help maintain the Heritage Trail and to provide for future improvements. Consider joining the many individuals, families and businesses who provide financial support for this terrific resource.

Where can I get a map? You'll be able to pick up a map at the trailhead shelter. Maps are available at the Village office or you can download a copy from the Village website www.stratfordwi.com. (Look under Park & Facilities)

Is future expansion planned? Preliminary planning for subsequent phases of Heritage Trail in the east half of the Village has been considered. Through future expansion of the trail, more private property owners would have the opportunity to provide recreational easements toward this public benefit.
